Will You Always Be With Us?

Seems to be a strange question doesn't it? But maybe not when it means, "Will you find your 'final resting place' at our church?" Perhaps you did not know but we have a small Cremation Cemetery at our church call The Gerald R. Lansing Memorial Prayer Garden. We often just call it the "Prayer Garden" or the "Memorial Garden." It is a legal cemetery where we can intern the ashes of our members and friends at a very nominal price. It will remain a cemetery even beyond the life of our church, which we plan to be a very long life, so it is as authentic as any other cemetery that anyone would use.

We have plenty of spaces that are available to our members and friends who wish to purchase them. The cost of the burial is as follows: \$350 for the space (which can be purchased now and reserved): \$190 for the bronze plaque on the monument stone, with the date tabs on those plaques costing \$25 a tab. (which needs to be purchased at time of plot purchase). The total cost then is \$590. (This cost is non-refundable and will be seen as a donation to the church if you or your loved ones should change your mind later.) This is still much cheaper than at a local cemetery. We want to keep it that way so that our members and friends can "be with us always."
